
Lake Wyaralong Sculpture Park



The Beaudesert and District Community Art Project (BADCAP) was the major funder of the *Wyaralong Sculpture Festival and Symposium* using funds from over 5 years of fundraising in the Scenic Rim community.

The Wyaralong Sculpture Festival and Symposium project was made possible by the Australian Government's Regional Arts Fund, which supports sustainable cultural development in regional, rural, and remote Australia to give artists and communities better access to opportunities to practice and experience the arts.

Additional funds were provided by the Queensland Government's Regional Arts Development Fund, an Arts Queensland and Scenic Rim Regional Council partnership that supports local arts and culture.

We also thank Gosford Quarries for their generous donation of local sandstone and acknowledge the support and authorisation from Seqwater that made this event and the establishment of Lake Wyaralong Sculpture Park possible.

Seven acclaimed Queensland, Australian and international sculptors created individual sculptures over 16 days to create the Lake Wyaralong Sculpture Park. These artworks reflect the recreational and environmental values enjoyed by visitors to Wyaralong Dam and Mt Joyce Recreation Park.

The sculptors were selected by the organising committee from concepts submitted by Expressions of Interest and were commissioned to create their sculpture during the Symposium held at Lake Wyaralong in 2015.
